In the broadcasting world, both on the technical side as well as the programming side, things are never static for long. 35 years ago, when we started out, personal computers were just starting to show up in radio stations...in fact we actually began with 2 of them. One for the on-air automation and one for the office. My, how that has changed. We now have many, many computers, and not only have they multiplied in quantity, they have also shrunk in size. The latest one we installed in a studio would literally fit in an old cigar box... if you remember what they were like!

Programming delivery has become streamlined as well. We went from reel-to-reel tapes to cassettes to cd's and mp3's...and now most every thing comes in via the internet or satellite. All storage is done digitally and quite inexpensively now compared to the cost in years gone by. Thankfully, the quality has improved as well, and the convenience of automatic delivery has reduced our workload considerably...that is, except when the internet is down or a PC locks up...oh well.



Broadcast equipment like transmitters, consoles, processors, and microphones have all become highly reliable and relatively trouble free (notice I said relatively). We also can now operate everything remotely, a lot even from a page on our cell phone! It is a vast improvement and allows us to operate 8 radio stations with just a handful of staff.

But in the midst of all this constant change and improvement, one thing remains the same as it was in July of 1990

when we first began broadcasting on 101.5FM. Then, and now, our only priority is to "see lives changed for Eternity as we broadcast God's Word through music and ministry." Don and Shirley Chagle had a vision of listener supported, Christian Radio, and what you listen to every day is the fruit of that vision and commitment to make Thy Word Network what it is today.
