
Floyd E. Turner An Attitude of Gratitude

The story is told of two boys who were headed into the classroom on the first day of the new school year. They were early, so they were looking around in the different rooms and as they poked their heads into the classroom just before they came to their own, they noticed two words written on the

chalkboard at the front of the room. Printed in large block letters were these words:

One boy looked at the other and asked, "I wonder what that means?" His friend answered quickly, "I don't know, and I don't care," as they quickly strolled on down the hallway.

- 3. We are entirely dependent upon God's supply for our financial needs, which now is over \$800,000 a year, and it comes primarily from individual listeners like you as they respond to His leading.
- 4. Every gift represents a sacrifice of some kind on the part of the giver, whether it is the lady who rolled up her pennies to send in a \$5 check, or the farmer who sent a load of soybeans to the grain elevator in our name, or the retired couple who transferred some of their retirement account to fund a project we were doing...it is all a sacrifice and we treat it accordingly.
- 5. Finally, as Paul admonished the Thessalonians to "not be ignorant, Brothers" (1 Thessalonians 4:13) and to "sorrow not as others who have no hope", we are looking for the Lord's return and are determined to proclaim that Good News, without apology, until He returns. Maranatha.

That is our mission and calling. Now, during this Sharathon season as we Give Thanks, we hope you will respond, not with apathy, but with a spirit of cheerful, generous giving to the Lord, for He has truly done great things...here at Thy Word Network and in our lives personally.
